The Nationally touring exhibit Adventure Base 100 will be making a stop in Columbus, Ohio the weekend of May 22-23 at the Columbus Zoo and Aquarium. A 10,000 square foot campus, Adventure Base 100 is stopping in only 40 cities across the country, and features the "Go Scouting" Dome which includes a multi-sensory experience that uses an IMAX-like domed screen with smells and sounds that make visitors feel like they are a part of the action. A ropes course and zip line experience, traveling Scout Museum, stage, time capsule, Green Screen experience and Scout Store are all a part of the exciting campus of Adventure Base 100.
